
# Newsletter.

### **Top Tips for Practising Good Recipient Care**

Following a request for information about what clients with great conception rates do to achieve this, we asked one such client with Hereford cattle to put together their own 'recipe for success' to share with you. With a conception rate over time of 60% (all known PD results, Tyndale IVF embryos only) they have kindly shared their recipe for success with us below:

- 1. Put in relevant groups and bolused with All Trace high iodine catte, 6/8 weeks prior to program starting.
- 2. Not mixing groups up until at least after pregnancy confirmed at 42 days.
- 3.On plenty of straw bedding and space in the pen and at feed face.
- 4. Recips fed on 89.5% grass silage, 3% straw, 5% rolled oats, 2% 33% protein, 0.5% general minerals from a mixer wagon as in below table actual fresh weight of feed. Feeding this 6 to 8 weeks before program and the same after implanting. Ideally with a good cow pat, rather than muck flying out.

FEED (5KG)	750KG Cow	450KG Heifer
Grass Silage	35	25
Straw	1.2	1
Rolled Oats	2	2
33% Protein with Acti Saf	0.8	0.5
General Purpose Minerals	0.2	0.1

5. Follow the instructions given by Peter May to the correct times. Make sure animals are handled stress free when jabbing, implanting and after implanting. We have always used pens near the crush where all work is done to house the recips.
